

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE

WHEREAS, the North Hudson Sewerage Authority (hereinafter "Authority") is a public body, duly formed under the Sewerage Authorities law, constituting Chapter 138 of the Laws of New Jersey of 1946, as amended (Chapter 14A of Title 40 of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated) and possesses the powers set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the Adams St WWTP Preliminary Facilities Bar Screen Upgrades Project consists of the replacement of six (6) slide gates and upgrade of three (3) mechanical bar screen racks at the Preliminary Facilities building; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a solicitation of bids for the Adams St WWTP Preliminary Facilities Bar Screen Upgrades Project, two(2) bids were received with the lowest responsible bid from Rapid Pump & Meter Service Co. Paterson, NJ, in the amount of \$416,890.00 as compared to the Engineer's Estimate of \$483,354; and

WHEREAS, the Facilities Review Board has reviewed the bids and recommends award of the contract to Rapid Pump & Meter Service Co. Of Paterson, New Jersey, in the amount of \$416,890.00.



On Wednesday, July 7, 2020 at 1:00 PM, bids were received for the above referenced contract. Two (2) bids were received that were in the amount of \$416,890.00 and \$689,000.00, respectively.

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The low bidder, Rapid Pump and Meter Company, Inc of Paterson, New Jersey, submitted a bid in the amount of \$416,890.00, which was \$272,110.00 less than the second low bidder submitted by Spectraserve. The low bid was \$66,464.00 lower than the Engineer's Estimate of \$483,354.00.

The low bidder, Rapid Pump and Meter, has demonstrated the ability to successfully complete the work on similar projects on the behalf of the Authority in the past.

Our office has contacted Rapid Pump and Meter and they have indicated that they are willing to enter into a contract with the Authority to perform the work.

In our opinion, the Authority has received a competitive and responsive bid for the project. Accordingly, we recommend that the Authority award the Contract to Rapid Pump and Meter in the amount of \$416,890.00 subject to review of legal counsel.
