Fletcher Cremer to commence same as the condition was determined to present a hazard to the health and welfare of the public (the "Emergency Declaration"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to fund the Emergency Declaration through its FY 2022/2023 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The authorization of the repair work to be completed on an emergency basis and direction of J. Fletcher Cremer to commence same as set forth in the Emergency Declaration is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

Section 2. The budget of the Authority is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this resolution to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

The force main was damaged by a contractor installing a drainage system for a new development at 800 Harbor Blvd due to the inaccurate location of the force main as-built drawings.

J Fletcher Creamer Inc. was engaged to make repairs to the force main on an emergency basis. Repairs were completed quickly, and the force main was returned to full service by 7:30 pm. All the wastewater leakage was contained and return to the sanitary sewer system.

After consulting with the Authority's legal counsel, it was determined to invoke the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, Emergency Purchase and Contracts, under the Local Public Contracts Law.

Since, this condition presented a hazard to the health and welfare of the public, the Authority Engineer Director on or about March 30, 2022, directed the commencement of the emergency work at this location by J Fletcher Creamer Inc.
