

RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND REAFFIRMING AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION**MOTIONED BY:** Velazquez**SECONDED BY:** Gardiner

WHEREAS, The North Hudson Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") is a public body, duly formed under the Sewerage Authorities Law, constituting Chapter 138 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1946, of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented (N.J.S.A. 40:14A-1 et seq.) and possesses the powers set forth therein;

WHEREAS, the Authority may, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.), negotiate or award a contract without public advertising for bids therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods of the performance of services;

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2023 the Authority Engineer was advised of the need for repair work to be completed on an emergency basis and delivered the certification set forth in Appendix A hereto directing J Fletcher Creamer to commence same as the condition was determined to present a hazard to the health and welfare of the public (the "Emergency Declaration"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to fund the Emergency Declaration in the amount of \$22,251.64 through its FY 2022/2023 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The authorization of the repair work to be completed on an emergency basis and direction of J Fletcher Creamer to commence same as set forth in the Emergency Declaration is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.


Section 2. The budget of the Authority is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this resolution to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Please be advised that on or about September 11, 2023, a heavy rain event caused a manhole frame and cover and portion of the roadway to become displaced by the rush of combined sewage in the W1234 outfall pipe on Boulevard East in Weehawken.

Emergency repairs were required as the damaged roadway is in a heavily traveled area near the entrance to the Lincoln Tunnel. Repairs included saw cutting and removal of the damaged pavement, resetting the displaced manhole casting, and repaving the area.

After consulting with the Authority's legal counsel, it was determined to invoke the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:A:11-6, Emergency Purchase and Contracts, under the Local Public Contracts Law.

Since this condition presented a hazard to the health and welfare of the public, the Authority Engineer directed on or about September 11, 2023 that J Fletcher Creamer mobilize and immediately commence the emergency repair work to be performed at this location.



Dear Mr. Conger:

On Monday September 11, 2023 at about 5:30 pm, the Authority was notified of a an issue with a manhole on the W1234 combined sewer outfall on Boulevard East in Weehawken. During a heavy rain event a manhole frame and cover as well as a large portion of the roadway was displaced by a rush of combined sewage. As the roadway (near the entrance to the Lincoln Tunnel) is heavily travel it was necessary to perform emergency repairs.

J Fletcher Creamer responded and completed repairs which included saw cutting and removal of damaged pavement, resetting the displaced manhole casting and repaving the disturbed area.
