Anticipated revenues for FY 2025 are \$57,666,480, which is a \$2,042,480, or 3.7%, increase over the prior year. Interest on investments increased by \$1,000,000 or 200%. This increase is based on revenue realized in the current year and the current interest rate market.

Net appropriations for FY 2025 are \$55,688,521, which is a \$1,090,577, or 2%, increase over the prior year. Trustee fees increased by \$125,000, or 34.7%. The increase to trustee fees is driven by additional NJIB loans closed in the prior year, which resulted in higher trustee fees. Miscellaneous administration increased by \$317,000, or 21.1%. This increase includes a new appropriation for public engagement and community outreach as required by the NJDEP in connection with the Authority's long term control plan.

The local economy is stable and should have no significant impact on the Authority's budget.

- **Officer**: A person elected or appointed to manage the authority's daily operations at any time during the year, such as the chairperson, vice-chairperson, secretary, or treasurer. For the purposes of this schedule, treat the authority's top management official and top financial officer as officers, if applicable. A member of the governing body may be both a commissioner and an officer for the purposes of this schedule.

- **Compensation:** All forms of cash and non-cash payments or benefits provided in exchance for services, including salaries and wages, bonuses, severance payments, deferred payments, retirement benefits, fringe benefits, and other financial arrangements or transactions such as perosnal vehicles, meals, housing, personal, and family education benefits, below-market loans, payment of personal or family travel, entertainment, and personal use of the Authority's prperty. Compensation includes payments and other benefits provided to both employees and independent contractors in exchange for services.
- **Reportable Compensation** (Use the most recent W-2 available): The aggregate compensation that is reported (or required to be reported) on Form W-2, box 1 or 5, whichever amount is greater, and/or Form 1099-MISC, box 7, for the most recent calendar year ended 60 days before the start of the proposed budget year.

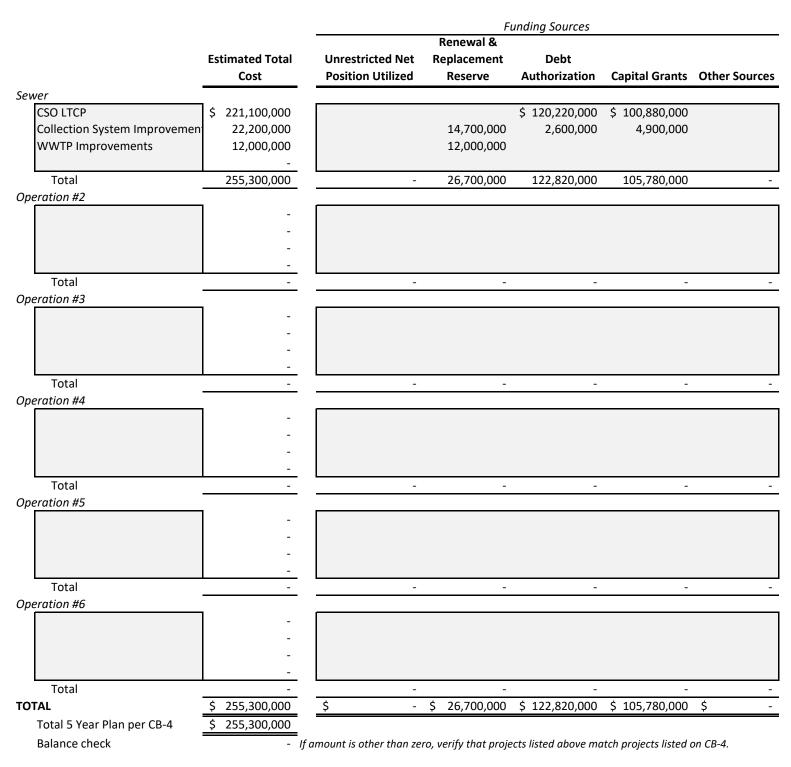
